**General Instructions to Students**

The End Examinations of Even Semester, A.Y.2021-22 for UG (except I Year), PG and Ph.D. Programmes are scheduled to be held from 20-05-22 to 31-05-22, and the following are the general instructions to the Students:

- 1) The End examinations of Even Semester for the A.Y. 2021-22 will be conducted in offline mode for those students who have registered and got eligibility as per the Academic Ordinances for Even semester 2021-22 at SPA Vijayawada.
- 2) **Weightage of Marks for End Semester – UG Programmes:**  
(Clause 6.8 of Academic Ordinance for UG Programmes, 2019:

Name of the Course	End Examination Weightage
Theory Courses (TC)	50%
Drawing Courses (DC)	50%
Jury courses (JC)	50%
Planning/Architectural Studio Courses (SC)	50%
Thesis (T)	40%

**Weightage of Marks for End Semester – PG& PhD Programmes:**

(Clause 6.7 of Academic Ordinance for PG & PhD Programmes, 2019:

Name of the Course	End Examination Weightage
Theory Courses (TC)	50%
Jury courses (JC)	50%
Planning/Architectural Studio Courses (SC)	50%
Thesis (T)	40%

- 3) Duration of the End Examination for subjects except Jury based courses and Drawing courses is 3:00 Hr (180 Minutes).
- 4) Venue for the examination will be announced one day prior to the commencement of exams and students should report to the examination hall 15 minutes before the exam starts. No entry will be allowed after the start of exam.
- 5) Use of any mobile phone, smart watches or any other electronic device or copying or cheating during the examination is strictly prohibited. Any infringement of these instructions shall entail disciplinary action by Unfair Means Committee. Use of Scientific calculators/tables will be permitted as per conditions/instructions mentioned in the question paper.
- 6) The marks statement of each subject & Grade sheet will be made available to students after the spot evaluation by subject coordinator(s)/paper evaluator. If any clarifications/discrepancies, the student may get it clarified/rectified through the subject coordinator(s)/ paper evaluator on the same day, before the marks are submitted to DUGC/DPGC.
- 7) Subject experts will be available for clarification of doubts in the question paper, if any and no student is allowed to leave the examination hall before the half time (90 Min) after the start of the examination
- 8) All the students must submit "No Dues" certificate to concerned departments for issue of Admit cards for the end examinations. Without admit cards students shall not be permitted to attend the examinations.
- 9) Students must ensure that they have signed the attendance sheet and got the invigilator signature on every additional sheet used in the exam.
