

A two-day, National Symposium on 'Memories of 22 October 1947' is being organized by the National Museum Institute of History of Art, Conservation and Museology, New Delhi in SKICC, Srinagar, Kashmir on 22-23 Oct 2020. The symposium will be accompanied by an exhibition on 'Invasion by Pakistan of Kashmir' at the same venue.
